## ~ DECORATION POLICY ~

### RESTRICTIONS ON MATERIALS, SIZE, QUANTITY, PLACEMENT, DURATION

- One display at a time, which shall not exceed 24" in height and depth.
- Multiple displays are permitted at interment and will be removed when faded or unsightly.
- Natural and artificial floral displays are placed in an approved container. No stands or wires allowed.
- Cut flowers are permitted at any time. If faded or unsightly they are removed during mowing and cleanup periods (spring and fall).
- Artificial floral displays including wreaths are permitted DEC 1 through MAR 31.
- Floral arrangements and wreaths may contain decorations consisting of non-plant materials, only as an incidental part of the arrangement or wreath (e.g. bows). No fabric or plastic banners permitted.

#### PLOT WITH ABOVE GROUND MONUMENT

- All floral displays or containers are placed directly in front of monument (grave side).
- No plantings behind the monument are permitted.
- Nothing shall be placed on the monument concrete surround.
- Container specifications:
  - No wider than monument foundation, between 6" 24" high, no greater than 15" depth.
  - Durable construction (stone, wood, composite, metal, plastic).
  - Ceramic, glass, and broken containers will be removed.
  - Plot owner may arrange with the office for an in-ground planter; plot owner is responsible for approval, and costs of installation in advance.

#### FLUSH MARKER WITHOUT PLOT MONUMENT

- Limited to one floral display placed adjacent to top edge of marker.
- Turn-down vases (receptacle below ground surface) can be installed by request, as arranged through the Cemetery
  office.

#### **COLUMBARIUM NICHE**

No displays are allowed; nothing may be placed on or attached to the structure.

#### **AMERICAN FLAGS**

 American flags of uniform size and design will continue to be exclusively provided and refreshed by the Cemetery on designated graves of American Veterans for Memorial Day.
